# CURRENT EVENTS 2012-2013

#### THE ARTICLE

- □ read a significant article—minimum 10 newspaper paragraphs
  - read the **complete** article (yes, from beginning to end)
  - if you do not understand, **reread** and/or ask questions
- adhere, staple, affix, copy and paste, etc. the article to the current events form
  - o you can also email a link to binder instead of attaching it (pbinder@pps.k12.or.us or binderpatrick@hotmail.com)



#### THE ASSIGNMENT SHEET

- title the entry with the current event assignment number ("Current Event #1")
- put an "x" in the box for the type of the article (not the section of the newspaper—see the "Types" section below)
- list the **source** of the article (the **name** of the newspaper, TV station, web site, etc.)
- provide the basics: who, what, where, when, and why
  - o the who, when, and where can be copied from the article
  - o restate the **what** using **words of your choice** rather than copying from the article
- locate and label where the event occurred on the map and for the class during the presentation

#### THE PRESENTATION

- present a brief (30-45") summary of the article to the class and locate it on the classroom map (current events #1-8)
- present a "Daily Show" presentation with an opening, theme song, transitions, and ending (current events #9-15)

#### TYPES OF ARTICLES: **NOT SECTION**

□ Local/Regional deal with the Portland Metro area, Oregon, & Washington

□ National within the United States, but not local or regional

from countries outside the United States International

□ Sports focuses on noteworthy sport issues—NO simple scores

□ Health focuses on interesting and new health issues

important business matters Business

bank, stock, jobs, and money related issues □ Economy

astronomy, biology, genetic, and related discovery and scientific news □ Science

□ Technology technological developments and new machinery

Politics governmental issues

### ARTICLE CHOICES:

- up you can present any type of article, but you may not complete more than **three** of any type of article during the first semester
- one newspaper is available on a daily basis on top of the black bookshelf (near the classroom door), but you are free to use the library's computers, home sources, etc.
  - o choose and read an article the day *before* your current event is due

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>you can prepare an article up to a week ahead of time as long as no one else has presented it



# **EVALUATION:**

- up you will receive a grade for each current event based on completion, accuracy, and presentation
- up you will also be assessed for timeliness, types of articles (a variety), and complexity of articles

### **DUE DATES & QUIZZES:**

- current events are due every other week & presented on the student's assigned day of the week
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> graders and students new to Binder Core are excused from presenting an article for current event #1, but they are expected to take part in the group quiz on 9/21
- current events quizzes are at the end of the second week of current events
  - quiz dates for semester #1 are: 9/21, 10/5, 10/19\*, 11/2, 11/16, 12/7, 1/11, & 1/25
  - quiz dates for semester #2 are: 2/15, 3/1, 3/15, 4/5\*\*, 4/26, 5/10, & 5/24
- \* 6<sup>th</sup> grade students who attend Outdoor School 10/17-19 are excused from current event quiz #3
- \*\* Spring Break separates the presentation of current event #12 and the quiz for the current events
