WRITING TECHNIQUES/SKILLS/DEVICES

Copy from the text four different quotes that use four different and identifiable writing techniques

- quotes should come from the breadth of the assigned reading
 - o pages 5, 8, 23, 27, and 30 of the assigned 32 pages and not just from page 1-5 or 30-32
- quotes need to stimulate conversation and have different possible perspectives
 - o some may like its use while others may not
- list the quote, the page(s) where it can be found, and another paragraph/page indicator
 - o if the quote is longer than one sentence, list the first three words of the quote, write three dots (...) and then the last three words of the quote
 - ° "Renshaw signed and...clanked faintly inside." from page 117, 2nd full paragraph
- list the writing technique/device that the quote demonstrates
 - o it could be dialogue, dialect, an analogy, simile, metaphor, hyperbole, flashback, foreshadowing, etc
 - o lists of techniques/devices/terms are available via Binder's website with explanations and examples
- explain the usage of the writing technique
 - o dialogue is used to express a character's words, but why would the author need to have the character speak?
 - o in addition, you might need to explain what the analogy or hyperbole means
- evaluate/critique the usage of the technique
 - o was it an effective use of a hyperbole?
 - o did it help or hurt the story?
